

## Maranacook Wave Race Update

Due to thin snow cover, we have to change the venue for the Maranacook Wave Race and the start times for the Maranacook Wave Race on Sat., 1/20. Here are the changes:

- The race will be held under the lights at Titcomb Mountain in Farmington
- The Girls' race will start at 5:00 pm and the Boys' race will follow, starting at 6:00 pm
- The start will still be in waves, but there will be 4 skiers per wave, starting every 30 seconds. The waves will still start with 12th graders, then 11th, 10th, and 9th
- The race will be 4 km long. It will consist of 2 laps of the Titcomb lighted loop with an additional climb added on and lit by a generator with auxiliary lights
- The entry fee will now be \$10/skier, with checks payable to the Maranacook Nordic Team
- There are middle school alpine and nordic races already scheduled at Titcomb during the day, so high school nordic teams are asked to arrive after 3:30 pm. You can register when you arrive and course preview starts at 4:00 pm

We know this change will require adapting transportation schedules and location, but hope you will understand that it is necessary in order to hold a high quality and fun race. It may also make it not possible for your team to attend the race. **Please let us know if you have registered, but can't make the new time/location** and accept our apologies.

It looks to be a cold day and evening, so come prepared for the weather. The heated hut will be available to racers as well as the lodge bathrooms.
